# 2019 Battle of the Books

#### **General Rules**

Teams are made up of four players.

As soon as someone buzzes in, the host stops reading the question.

The person who buzzes in must answer the question, even if they buzzed accidentally.

If a team gets the question wrong, the other teams have a chance to answer it.

Teammates may not talk to each other during the question or answer.

Teams lose a point (-1) for talking and the question is thrown out.

#### **Point Structure**

Teams lose five points (-5) for every incorrect answer.

Titles must be completely correct.

Teams earn five points (+5) for every correct answer.

If a player gets a question correct, that player has a chance to earn three extra bonus points (+3) by knowing the author's last name.

If the player says the first and last name, both must be correct.

Pronunciations of difficult names that demonstrate that that player knows the name will be accepted.

### **Audience Etiquette**

Audience members must listen quietly, or they will be asked to leave the room. Host will decide whether to replace the question as needed.

#### Final Standings for Sacajawea Championship Game

Who is considered a top three team? Each team is ranked based on wins <u>and</u> points scored. An average is then taken between the two. In case of a tie, the 'win' rank is the first tiebreaker.

The top three teams will be chosen based on an average ranking of their wins and point totals. For example, a team that has the most wins and the third most points, would have an average ranking of 2 [(1+3)/2 = 2]. A team that is 3rd in wins and 4th in points would have an average ranking of 3.5 [(3+4)/2 = 3.5]. The lower the average, the higher the rank. If there is a tie (two teams with the same average), then the team with more wins would be ranked higher.

#### **District Battle**

The winner of the Sacajawea Championship Game will represent the school at the district battle Saturday June 9 at the downtown Vancouver public library. All teams are encouraged to come cheer them on.
